

Tournament Rules.

All matches are played in accordance with the Laws of the game as laid down by the International Football Association Board, as issued by F.I.F.A and in accordance with the rules of the D.B.U. (Dansk Boldspil-Union).

The organizer has received the necessary permission to host the tournament from the D.B.U.

1. Special rules

In categories U19, U17, U15 the size of the ball used is 5

In categories U14, U13, U12, U11 it is a size 4 ball.

In categories U12/U11 following rules applies:

- On goal kicks and free kicks inside the penalty area (for defending teams), the ball is in play even if the ball does not leave the penalty-box.
- The ball does not have to leave the penalty-box and come back before the goalkeeper can play the ball with his hands.
- Corner kicks are taken on spot where the end line/goal line meets the side of the penalty box.
- It is allowed to let one extra player enter the field as long as his/her team is behind with three goals or more. The additional player must be withdrawn, if the lead is reduced to less than three goals.
- If a team gets an additional three goals behind, one more player may enter.
- U13 9-a side is played with offside.

2. Referees.

All matches will be controlled by referees affiliated to the D.F.U. (Dansk Fodbolddommer Union) from U13B-U19. From U11/7-U13/9 local referees can be used.

3. Teams.

Teams sanctioned by their national football association are entitled to participate in this tournament.

4. Team Leader

Every team must be accompanied by an adult (over 18 years of age). The name, address and date of birth of this adult must be listed clearly on his team's registration sheet. This adult will be deemed to be the team leader and he will be responsible for the behavior of his players, on and off the field of play. He will be held responsible for the actions of his team within the sports complex and within all other facilities available to the group.

5. Age categories.

- U19 - Boys born on/after 01.01.99
- U17 – Boys/Girls born on/after 01.01.01
- U15 – Boys/Girls born on/after 01.01.03
- U13 – Boys/Girls born on /after 01.01.05 (Girls 8-a-side)
- U12 - Boys born on /after 01.01.06 (8-a-side)
- U11 - Boys born on /after 01.01.07 (7-a-side)

6. Age Control.

Prior to commencement of the tournament the team leader must submit, to the tournament committee, a registration sheet, which contains the full name, date of birth and shirt number of every player in his team. All players must provide proof of their age and identity. They may be asked to show this proof at any time.

Every player must wear the wrist bracelet given by the organizers – also during matches.

7. Duration of Play.

Categories	General	Finals

8. Preliminary rounds.

The final positions of teams in the preliminary rounds will be determined by the number of points attained. The points system applied will be:

- 3 points for a win, 1 point for a draw, 0 points for a loss.

Where teams are level on points in their group the following will apply:

1. the result of the mutual match,
2. Goal difference,
3. most goals scored,
4. penalty kicks/coin toss

Placing matches - Intermediate rounds/finals. In the event of a draw, penalty kicks will be taken to determine the winners.

9. Team Sheets and Substitutions.

"Free" substitutions are allowed during the whole game (7/11 + 5 players per match).

A player can play only for one team during tournament

10. Shirts.

All teams must bring a alternate set of playing outfit. If prior to the match the referee is of the opinion the colors of the clubs are too similar, the club mentioned first in the program will be obliged to play in shirts of a different color.

11.. Disciplinary measures.

When a player is given a caution the referee will mark this by showing him/her the yellow card. This means that the player has to leave the field for a time-period of 5 minutes. The player cannot reenter the field until he receives permission from the referee. Any player who has been sent off (red card) or has received two cautions is not eligible to play in their team's next game.

All miscon-duct will be given to the tournament office so addition penalty is an option.

In case of group matches (preliminary rounds) all results of a team will be invalidated with the result 0-3 in the follo-wing cases:

- if that team is late for a game without a valid reason,
- if that team uses an ineligible player,
- if the referee has to abandon a game due to misconduct of players of that team.

In the intermediate- and final rounds (not group stage) the team concerned loses in the cases mentioned automatically its match with the result 0-3.

12. Protests.

The referee's decision in all matters concerning points of play shall be final and binding, therefore protests in this area are not accepted.

All other protests should be made only by the responsible team leader to the tournament committee not later than 15 minutes after the match. When filing a protest DKK 200,-/25€ should be paid up front in "protest costs". If the protest is acknowledged, this sum will be reimbursed.

The tournament committee's decision on all protests is final and binding. The tournament committee also decides in cases not foreseen in these tournament rules.

13.Alteration match schedule.

The tournament committee has the right to alter the match schedule should unforeseen circumstances occur.

14.Responsibility.

It is the responsibility of each team to make sure that adequate insurance coverage is provided for their players. The tournament organizers and Euro-Sportring are not responsible for damage to, and loss or theft of possessions or equipment of participants or clubs. They are also not responsible for personal harm or injury to participants.
