

Tournament rules 2019
Top Oss Cup

1. Regulations

The matches are played according to the rules of the "International Football Association Board" of FIFA and the rules of the K.N.V.B.

The tournament organizer puts together a tournament committee that is responsible for the entire tournament execution.

Validity: Due to possible changes up to the tournament, the latest version published on this website will always replace previous versions.

Therefore always read the rules online.

2. Arbitration

The matches are led by referees. Each team itself provides an assistant referee for their matches.

3. Teams

Teams that have received the approval of their national football association are entitled to participate in this tournament.

4. Team leader

Each team must be accompanied by a team leader older than 18 years. His name, address and date of birth must be known to the organization.

The team leader is responsible for the behavior of the players, both at the sports complex and in other accommodations, that are made available to the participants.

5. Categories

U17 players born on or after 01.01.'02 (11 players)

U16 Players born on or after 01.01.'03 (11 players)

U15 Players born on or after 01.01.'04 (11 players)

U13 players born on or after 01.01.'06 (9 a side)

U12 / 9 Players born on or after 01.01.'07 (9 a side)

U11 / 7 players born on or after 01.01.'08 (7 a side)

U09 / 7 players born on or after 01.01.'10 (7 a side)

U09 / 5 players born on or after 01.01.'10 (5 a side)

G17 players born on or after 01.01.'02

G15 / G13 / 8 players born on or after 01.01.'04 players born on or after 01.01.'06 (8 a side)

By using different ages for a number of national football associations, the tournament organizer is entitled to grant dispensation.

Check:

Before the start of the tournament, the team leader must have the player list on which the name, birth date and back number are listed per player mentioned at the tournament secretariat.

All players must be in possession of an official ID that must be available at any time.

The same player may play in only one team during the entire tournament.

6. Playing time

All matches: 2 x 15 minutes

The competitions are started and ended centrally. The moment it is announced, it will end immediately.

That does NOT apply to an evt. penalty still to be taken. A ball that is already on its way and leads to a goal, still money.

7. Placement

Group matches:

The ranking is determined by the number of points. The points are given as follows: win 3 points, draw 1 point and lose 0 points.

If teams end in a tie, the ranking is determined as follows:

If there is no difference yet, each team will take 3 penalties.

Subsequent grounds: Where applicable: in the event of a tie, penalties are taken in accordance with FIFA rules.

The distance is 11 meters, the distance for the U09 is 8 meters.

Finals: Where applicable: in the event of a draw, penalties are taken in accordance with FIFA rules.

The distance is 11 meters, the distance for the U09 is 8 meters.

8. Competition

For all categories, with the exception of the U09 category, 5 players (including 1 goalkeeper) are listed per game per game

listed players may be exchanged *.

A swapped player may not return to the game. Unlimited changes can be made to the U09 category.

Players may only play for one team during the entire tournament. The match of the team in which this player playing illegally counts as lost (0-3).

9. Tenue

If, in the opinion of the referee, the club colors of both teams differ too little before the start of a match, the first-mentioned association is obliged to play in a uniform of a different color.

10. Disciplinary measures

A player who receives an official warning (yellow card) receives a five-minute time penalty. If a player from the field has been sent (red card) or has received two official warnings, he will be excluded from the next match.

The referee will inform the tournament committee immediately after the match. A player who receives a second red card, is excluded from participating in the remainder of the tournament. All reports about misconduct will be made by the tournament organizer be sent to the national football association that will forward these reports to the relevant national association.

In the event of group matches, all results of a team will be declared invalid if:

- that team is not present on time without a valid reason;
- that team ends up with an unauthorized player;
- due to misconduct of the players of that team, the referee decides to stop the game.

In the intermediate and final rounds, if there are no pool matches, lose in the aforementioned cases the relevant team automatically with 0-3

11. Protests

Protests regarding the decisions of the referees are not possible. Protests related to others matters must be submitted by the team leader to the tournament committee no later than 15 minutes after the match submitted in writing. The tournament committee also decides on matters not covered by these regulations. The decision of the tournament committee is binding.

12. Competition program

The tournament committee has the right to change the game schedule in the event of unforeseen circumstances

13. Liability

The participating clubs are themselves responsible for adequate insurance for the players. The organizers and Euro Sportring are not liable for personal injury and loss or theft of property of the participants

14. Alcohol consumption

It is strictly forbidden for participants in Top Oss Cup to drink alcohol along the fields during the tournament.

If this does happen, the tournament organization can exclude the team of the relevant player from participating. Age estimation remains difficult, in case of doubt, an ID card is requested.

15. Discipline

Players / teams that misbehave in any way during the weekend on and / or outside the football field can be excluded from participating in the Top Oss Cup. The decision on this is in the hands of the board of the Eurosportring Foundation and the club where the tournament is played. In addition, it is important to realize that our referees are always protected, treated unfairly a declaration will be made against the relevant player / parent / official and at the same time this person must leave the premises.
